





GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE HAS HAD A VERY GOOD 2019 FIRST QUARTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OPERATING WELL UNDER BUDGET AND THE COURSES COMING OUT OF THE WINTER IN VERY GOOD SHAPE. WE ARE AMONG THE BEST CONDITIONED COURSES IN THE AREA.

SPRING GREEN-UP

- o THE GOLF COURSES ARE GREENING UP NICELY AND FINALLY DRYING OUT AND GETTING FIRMER.
- WE HAVE APPLIED OUR SPRING PRE-EMERGE HERBICIDE AND FERTILIZER APPLICATIONS.
- OUR GREENS ARE IN VERY GOOD SHAPE AFTER THE WINTER AND ARE SOME OF THE BEST IN OUR AREA.

BUNKER MAINTENANCE

- o ALL BUNKERS ARE BEING EDGED OVER THE NEXT TWO WEEKS.
- WE HAVE CHANGED OUR BUNKER MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES TO HELP REDUCE FRIED-EGG LIES AND WILL BE WORKING IN THE COMING WEEKS TO TEST OUT SEVERAL SAND MIXES TO ADD TO THE BUNKERS.

OTHER ITEMS

- OUR ROUGH HEIGHT HAS BEEN LOWERED THIS YEAR. WE WILL MAINTAIN A LOWER HEIGHT OF CUT IN THE ROUGH THROUGHOUT THE GROWING SEASON.
- WE ARE ADDING MORE SHAPE TO THE FAIRWAYS TO ENHANCE PLAY AND IMPROVE VISUAL APPEAL.
- AERATION ALONG CART PATHS HAS BEGUN AND WILL BE DONE THROUGHOUT THE GROWING SEASON TO HELP KEEP TURF IN HIGH WEAR AREAS ALONG THE PATH.
- OUR COURSES ARE VERY CLEAN WEED-WISE AND WE WILL BE WORKING WITH AN UPDATED WEED CONTROL PROGRAM TO FURTHER IMPROVE TURF HEALTH AND WEED CONTROL THIS GROWING SEASON.
- MOLE CRICKETS ARE BEING TREATED THIS MONTH ON BOTH COURSES IN AREAS WHERE THERE
 IS DAMAGE. A SECOND TREATMENT WILL BE MADE TO AREAS THAT NEED IT.

- GEX DR. PROJECT. FACILITIES MAINTENANCE STAFF PARTICIPATED IN THE GEX DR. PROJECT COMPLETING INSTALLATION OF NEW LIGHTING AT THE FOUNTAIN AND PAINTING THE SIGN AND STRUCTURES.
- TWO NEW AC UNITS HAVE BEEN INSTALLED A THE CLUB AND ARE WORKING WELL HELPING KEEP THE BUILDING MORE COMFORTABLE AND IMPROVING EFFICIENCY.
- THE MONUMENTS AT ALL THREE LIGHT SIGNS HAVE BEEN PAINTED.
