Craft/Vendors:

We will provide a designated space in The Club at Diamondhead main parking circle. You will be responsible for bringing your own table(s), chairs, and pop-up tents. Electricity is not provided. No store-bought or garage sale items are allowed. Products sold must be at least 50% hand-crafted.

Set up will be Saturday, October 22, beginning at 8:30 am. Booths must be set up by 10:45 am, open at 11:00 am, and remain open until 4:00 pm.

Vehicles will not be allowed to park in the vendor area – they are only allowed to load and unload. We will have assistance available.

Food Truck Vendors:

- **No beverages may be sold out of a booth/truck at any time.**
- Vendors are permitted to use quiet generators
- All food truck vendors must display a Health Permit and email a copy along with the completed application.
- Set up will be Saturday, October 22, beginning at 8:30 am. Must be set up by 10:45 am, open at 11:00 am, and remain open until 4:00 pm
- Must obey all pertinent safety codes and laws, including, but not limited to, fire, safety, and parking regulations
- The Club at Diamondhead and Property Owners Association reserves the right to shut down any vendors not meeting cleanliness and food storage safety codes and laws
- Food trucks will provide all required equipment for operations and sales
- Food truck A-frame signs cannot extend further than 3-feet from the facade of the booth. Food trucks are liable for any injury or damage caused by signs
- Any food vendors that fry must do so in a food truck only.
- No grease or gray water disposal is available
- No water or ice is provided
- Food trucks are responsible for removing debris and waste at the designated location and ensuring the general cleanliness of the area

I agree to forever release and hold harmless The Club at Diamondhead and Diamondhead Property Owners Association from liability arising from accident, injury, an act of vandalism, or theft during the 2022 Club at Diamondhead & POA Fall Fest and from product liability due to the sale of merchandise during the Fest.
